A beta of less than 1.00 indicates lower risk than the market; a beta of greater than 1.00 indicates higher risk than the market. **R Squared** represents the percentage of the portfolio's movement that can be explained by the market. **Turnover** is a measure of the Fund's trading activity which represents the portion of the Fund's holdings that has changed over a twelve-month period as reported in the Fund's current annual report. **Price/Earnings** is the ratio of a stock's price to its earnings per share. **Price/Book** is the ratio of a stock's price to its book value per share. **EPS Growth Rate** is the projected growth rate in earnings per share for the next five years. **Return on Equity** is the average amount of net income returned as a percentage of shareholder's equity over the past five years. **Asset Weighted Market Cap** is the value of a corporation as determined by the number of outstanding shares of common stock multiplied by the price per share.

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
